Chief Lucas also reported that the Police Department's annual Shop with a Cop was held on Wednesday, December 20, 2023 with twenty-five (25) kids having participated.

Chief Lucas further reported that there was not an abundance of traffic issues associated with the Winter Fantasy of Lights (WFOL) held in Harrison Smith Park in December 2023. It was noted that there was a car fire that occurred in the park during the WFOL on Saturday, December 23, 2023.

It was noted that applications for police dispatchers are due later this week.

Chief Lucas indicated that he will present his stats for 2023 at the February 5, 2024 Safety Committee meeting.

There being no further business, the Chairman declared the meeting adjourned.
