

SAFETY COMMITTEE

January 11, 2024

The January 11, 2024 special Safety Committee meeting was called to order at 10:30 a.m. in Council Chambers by Kenneth Wessler, Chairman. Safety Committee members present were Julia Lemire, John Walker, and Kenneth Wessler.

Others present included: Kyle McColly, Mayor; Jared Lucas, Police Chief; and Sarah Bennett, Clerk.

The purpose of this meeting was to make a conditional job offer to a police officer candidate.

It was noted that the Safety Committee members and Police Department personnel have conducted interviews with the three police officer candidates having completed the police officer civil service examination.

A motion was made by Mr. Wessler, seconded by Mr. Walker, to enter into an executive session to discuss police officer candidates. Upon Roll Call, all members voted Yes. The Chairman declared the motion carried. Upon completion of the executive session, the Safety Committee reconvened into regular session.
