

SAFETY COMMITTEE

May 20, 2024

The May 20, 2024 special Safety Committee meeting was called to order at 6:30 p.m. in Council Chambers by Kenneth Wessler, Chairman. Safety Committee members present were Julia Lemire, John Walker, and Kenneth Wessler.

Others present included: Kyle McColly, Mayor; Mike MaGinn, Fire Chief; and Sarah Bennett, Clerk.

The purpose of this meeting was to discuss a request to increase the “Eclipse” time from eight (8) hours to twelve (12) hours for full-time firefighters.

Chief MaGinn requested the Safety Committee members consideration of recommending to City Council an increase of the “Eclipse” time for full-time firefighters to twelve (12) hours, similar to the request presented at the May 6, 2024 the Safety Committee meeting by Police Chief Lucas for full-time Police Dispatchers, Police Lieutenants, and Police Officers.

A motion was made by Mrs. Lemire, seconded by Mr. Walker to recommend to City Council to amend Ordinance No. 222-13 to increase the “Eclipse” time for full-time firefighters from eight (8) hours to twelve (12) hours. Upon Roll Call, all members voted Yes. The Chairman declared the motion carried.

There being no further business, the Chairman declared the meeting adjourned.
