A motion was made by Mr. Rowe, seconded by Mr. Korte, for the approval and payment of bills totaling \$71,771.78. Upon Voice Vote, all members voted Yes. The Chairman declared the motion carried.

The minutes of the December 18, 2023 Service Committee meeting, having been mailed to each Service Committee member, were approved as received.

Trash collection on Monday, April 8, 2024, the day of the Solar Eclipse, was discussed. Mayor McColly indicated that the Wyandot County Landfill and the Wyandot County Recycling Center have announced that they will be closed on that day. Mr. Taylor stated that in anticipation of traffic in the City being heavy on Monday, April 8, 2024 because of visitors here to view the eclipse, that trash normally picked up on Mondays will instead be picked up on Tuesday, April 9, 2024. Mr. Korte indicated that options for individuals needing to dispose of their trash during the time surrounding this event will need to be considered, including the trash receptacles in the downtown area.

It was decided that due to the Martin Luther King Jr. Day holiday on Monday, January 15, 2024, the next Service Committee meeting will be held on Tuesday, January 16, 2024.

Mr. Schoenberger reported that Water Treatment Plant employees recently washed the ultrafiltration and nanofiltration membranes at the Water Treatment Plant. Mr. Schoenberger noted that membranes were also pinned and those membranes are holding up well.

It was noted that Mr. Schoenberger and Mr. Honaker are investigating complaints from residents of Brookview Subdivision regarding decreased water pressure. Mr. Honaker indicated that he will be conducting pressure tests around the City to establish a comparison.

Mr. Taylor reported that during a recent snow/ice weather event that Mr. Brian Gottfried, Wastewater Treatment Plant employee, and Mr. Nate Bash, Sanitation Department employee, assisted with training new employees in plowing and spreading salt.

Mr. Taylor noted that all of the Street Department trucks have been serviced for winter.

Mr. Taylor also reported that he plans for the Street Department employees to start patching streets beginning later this week.

Mayor McColly reported that he is still looking for grant opportunities to fund water and wastewater projects. Mayor McColly noted that Mr. Taylor presented information to him recently for grant funding for the purchase of salt for roadways.

There being no further business, the Chairman declared the meeting adjourned.
