

SERVICE COMMITTEE

September 2, 2025

The September 2, 2025 Service Committee meeting was called to order at 5:30 p.m. in Council Chambers by Dale Rowe, Chairman. Service Committee members present were Aaron Korte, Dale Rowe, and Andy Voorheis.

Others present included: Kyle McColly, Mayor; Dave Schneider, Collections System Supervisor; Aaron Schoenberger, Water Treatment Plant Supervisor; Lisa Andres; Mike Andres; John Walker; Brian Hemminger, Daily Chief Union; and Sarah Bennett, Clerk.

The summary of bills totaling \$247,880.62 was presented.

A motion was made by Mr. Korte, seconded by Mr. Voorheis, for the approval and payment of bills totaling \$247,880.62. Upon Voice Vote, all members voted Yes. The Chairman declared the motion carried.

The minutes of the August 18, 2025 Service Committee meeting, having been mailed to each Service Committee member, were approved as received.

Mrs. Lisa Andres, 467 North Sandusky Avenue, addressed the Service Committee requesting the placement of stone in the unimproved alley located to the rear of her property. Service Committee members indicated that they would like to look at the area and consult with Mr. Brad Taylor, Street and Sanitation Supervisor, regarding this matter.

It was noted that Fall Clean-Up for residential sanitation customers will take place from Monday, September 22, 2025 thru Friday, September 26, 2025.

Mr. Schoenberger reported that last week he met with water consultant Walter Gnagy and they are close to having the Water Management Plan completed.

Mr. Schoenberger also reported that the City's water quality continues to improve with the taste and odor compound numbers continuing to decrease.

Mr. Schoenberger indicated that the Water Treatment Plant has gone back to operating with two (2) shifts.

Mr. Schoenberger further reported that samples are being taken from the river for future possible pumping directly from the river.

Mr. Schneider reported that he will be repairing sink holes on Duck Pond Road and Eulalia Avenue soon, and he will also be working to lift some manholes.

Mayor McColly reported that City Council will be considering a Resolution at their meeting to be held later this evening to submit an application for funding from the Ohio Public Works Commission (OPWC) for the Sandusky River Waterline Crossing Project.

Mayor McColly also reported that he has been working with Mr. Eric Honaker, Water Distribution Supervisor, and they have discussed water testing with two different companies.

Mayor McColly thanked everyone for celebrating Mr. Doug Keller's retirement on Friday, August 29, 2025.

There being no further business, the Chairman declared the meeting adjourned.
